Transport

There is limited accessible parking available on site. Guests requiring accessible parking will need to participate in a random draw to determine car park recipients. Guest will need to visit the below website to complete the Accessible Parking Random Draw Entry Form.

PINK ACCESSIBLE PARKING

For those that do not receive a park on site, there are alternative accessible transport options available.

There is a dedicated **accessibility zone for drop off and pick** up located on Pride Close at the Gate D/Gate E entrance to the stadium (Southern end). Those using this drop off and pick up area will need to advise Traffic Controllers as they drive into the venue to gain access to Pride Close. Guests exiting the car, will then need to walk around the round-a-bout, past the Cowboys Training Field and then cross the road to gain access to the stadium plaza.

Please note the driver is required to stay with the vehicle at all times and is not allowed to idle for extended periods of time if waiting for guests to exit the venue.





If arriving by taxi, guest can utilise the **accessibility zone for drop off.** If a guest requires a wheelchair certified taxi post event, there will be a limited number available at the **accessible zone for pick up.**

There is a FREE **Park & Ride Shuttle Service** running from Lou Litster Park that is accessibility friendly. There is priority parking close to the pick up at Lou Litster and the drop off point for guests is approximately 100m to Gate D at the venue.






Access Between Field and Level 1

If ticketed to the field, guests can move between the field and the Level 1 Concourse for supplementary venue services. Guest are able to use any aisle to go up to Level 1 from the field however they will need to re-enter the field by dedicated aisles from Level 1 concourse.



If unable to use stairs, there is a lift available to use from the Service Drive at Gate E to move from field level to Level 1 and then back to Ground Floor.









Entry Gate

Tickets will say enter via Gate A however if guests can't use stairs, they will need to enter via Gate B which is on the eastern side of the venue.




If a guest enters via Gate A, access to the field for the Golden Circle Pods are:

- Golden Circle Pod 1 via Aisle 112
- Golden Circle Pod 2 via Aisle 120





If guests enter via Gate B, this will be straight onto the field and will need to follow directions to the pod they are ticketed to.

Amenities


There will be temporary wheelchair toilets in the service drive off the field for use. There are also existing wheelchair toilets located on the Level 1 concourse for use.


There are 4 parents rooms available for use on Level 1 in each corner of the venue, as well as existing male and female toilets.

There is an accredited Changing Places Facility located in the North-West corner of the Level 1 concourse (near Aisle 111) and includes a full-sized change table, ceiling hoist and shower. Please note guests are required to bring their own sling.











Food and Beverage

There will be 4 bars located in the Service Drive off the field that will be selling beverages and a small selection of packet chips. For additional food offerings, field patrons will have access to the food outlets on Level 1.

General Accessibility Information

Auslan Stage Left

Auslan Stage Left are providing quality theatre-trained Auslan interpreters to ensure that P!NK's show is an immersive, engaging and accessible arts experience. This section has been ticketed however if guests haven't bought a ticket into this area and require these services, they can enquire with the venue's customer service staff on seating availability.

Hidden Disabilities Sunflower

The Sunflower lanyard is a simple tool for guests to share that they have a hidden disability voluntarily. By wearing the Sunflower, the guest is just letting the venue and show-goers know that they might need extra help, understanding or just more time.

Guests can access the dedicated viewing area and quiet room when they show their lanyard to venue staff.

Quiet Room

To create a more sensory inclusive and accessible concert experience for everyone, there is a quiet room available at this show. Please ask customer service staff to assist in locating this room. Please note there is no view of the show in this quiet room.

Accessible View Platform

A dedicated viewing platform will be made for those guests on the field. Please ask customer services staff to assist in locating this platform.
